VISA and Entry Information

Participants should independently verify visa and entry requirements applicable to their nationality. Those requiring invitation letters should indicate this in their registration email. Visa requirements vary by jurisdiction. For example, UK applicants may consult the website of the Chinese Embassy in the United Kingdom: <http://gb.china-embassy.gov.cn/eng/>. Certain foreign nationals may qualify for China's 240-hour transit-without-visa policy when arriving by international air travel and meeting all applicable requirements. Different rules may apply for entry by train, land border crossings, or other means of transport. Participants are responsible for obtaining all necessary travel documents before departure.
