Terms of Reference

The Partnership Committee is responsible for establishing or nourishing strategic partnership with other organizations on a regional, international and supranational level.

General Duties

- III already has relationships with, among others, INSOL International, INSOL Europe, American College of Bankruptcy (ACB), National Conference of Bankruptcy Judges (NCBJ) and International Women in Restructuring (IWIRC). The Committee will be responsible to continue to nurture the existing relationships and work closely together to increase ties.
- The Committee will be responsible for establishing new relationships with organizations, especially in countries where III would like to increase its membership.
- The Committee should consider whether to have one person responsible for one organization. The responsible person will develop ideas to improve the relationship with the assigned organization.
- Ideas to improve relations would include running panels at the other organization's conferences (e.g. ABI, ACB, NCBJ) or engage with the other organization in activities (e.g. Ian Fletcher International Moot Court Competition) that will enhance the III brand.

Reporting

- The Partnership Committee is invited to regularly report to the Executive Committee by call and is invited to attend an in-person meeting at the Annual Conference.
